Kia orana,

It was lovely to open this week raising the Cook Islands Flag to celebrate language week. It has also been a real pleasure to see all our students back after the holidays and ready for a full on term going for their goals! We are excited for polyfest this week and look forward



to seeing hundreds of our students and parents celebrating our cultures down at Te Rauparaha Arena on Friday. Our Kapa Haka group, who already did an awesome job opening the Wellington Regionals, will also be there. Thank you so much to all the parents and relatives who coached and helped with supervision, costumes and all the crucial behind the scenes work. Well done to all our students for their many hours of hard work that will lead to amazing performances and lots of credits.

We also look forward to seeing you at our Goal Review Day on Wednesday 11th August to discuss how the students are progressing towards their goals for the year. Make sure that you also talk about long term pathways and what that might mean for the subject choices for 2022 that will be coming up later this term. Year 13s are starting to apply for courses and scholarships at university or polytechnic next year, if they intend to continue with their studies. If they plan to look for work, make sure they are connecting with Ms Walker, Ms Turner or Nadia in the careers team. We want to work on communicating clearly to help students find their pathway. Please come along to the PC Whanau meeting on Tuesday 10th August at 5:30 pm in the staffroom to discuss this.

Thank you for your work in getting our students in full school uniform this term. Following student requests, the Board of Trustees have agreed to add cargo shorts to our school uniform and they will soon be on our uniform racks at The Warehouse. They will also start stocking our school trousers, which are currently available through the school office but beginning to sell out. We have reminded students in assembly that they can only wear school uniform items at school and we will loan them uniform if they need it for the day. If you need support getting the full uniform, just let us know.

Our second semester has now started for Ko te Hapori courses and junior options. Many are completely full and students wanting to change their choices may not get their next choice. As our school roll continues to increase, we will be offering even more courses and options for next year. There will be a change to Ko te Hapori in 2022 with juniors having just one morning a week, while seniors have courses for four lessons per week, like their other subjects. This will allow teachers more time to teach other subjects to juniors and to focus on senior credits in Ko te Hapori courses.

I wish seniors all the best working towards NCEA success this term. By the end of term, many will have already passed the 80 credits for Level 1 or 60 credits for Level 2 or 3. Lots of students are also working towards Merit and Excellence endorsements. There will be a final four weeks of senior classes in Term 4 before exams, along with mahi tahi in the holidays and after classes finish for those who need it.
